

Crisis management - Network Manager (NM) and European Aviation Crisis Coordination Cell (EACCC)






Crisis management – progress so far



- Key players NM with support of EACCC
- NM improved its ops processes, mitigates sudden capacity/demand imbalance
- EACCC established links to the State Focal Points
 - Coordination between network and national level
 - Information and communication messages synchronised
 - Recommendations for strategic or political actions prepared
- Positive results:
 - Robust safety risk assessment methodology → harmonisation
 - Strong European wide coordination
 - Encouraging information sharing process





NUCLEAR 14 – scenario & participants




Fatal incident at a Nuclear Power plant (NPP)

TO + 1h State authorities order evacuation of the vicinity of the NPP

T0 + 2h NPP meltdown \rightarrow airspace above (30km radius closed)

T0 + 2h45 NM receives the dispersion model output → forecast SFC-500m (RSMC)



SECURITY 15 - – scenario & participants



Held on 2-3 February 2016

Bombs going off at 2 European airports simultaneously

Unclear if these bombs were just targeting the airport

Aviation all over Europe under threat

How will the different states (directly affected and other) react to the threat?

- 18 States + EACCC
- Security and aviation experts from airports, airlines, EC & NM



ICAO volcanic ash exercise: VOLCEX 16 - 11 & 12 October 2016







- More than 10 States from Central & Southeast Europe
- Link to ICAO initiative to promote enhancement of SAR facilities
 & services within EUR Region and adjacent regions
- Next step: establishment of a Regional SAR Committee
 - provide support to members in building Aeronautical SAR capacities
 - enhance cross-border cooperation among State in this area
