# Features of the CASE Project

- EU-funded
- ECAC-implemented
- 4-year Project, started early 2016
- Implementation of capacity-building activities in the field of aviation security



# Methods of the CASE Project

- Sharing expertise and transferring best practices...
- ...thanks to experts nominated by ECAC Member States for the Project
- Working jointly with Partner States' experts...
- ...expected to increase the pool of CASE Project experts
- No provision of security equipment
- No funding
- Selection criteria, especially re: national activities



## Activities of the CASE Project (1/2)

- National activities (i.e. to benefit one given Partner State)
- Adapted to their specific priorities/concerns/threats:
  - Mentoring: MANPADS, available technologies...
  - Coaching activities: on-site coaching of national auditors, covert tests...
  - Training: BPNAs...
  - Risk assessment: cargo audits, landside vulnerability assessments



## Activities of the CASE Project (2/2)

- Regional activities (i.e. regional workshops)...
- ...in principle open to all States in the scope...
- ...and dedicated to current key issues in AVSEC, such as:
  - Latest emerging threats
  - Risk management
  - Security culture
  - Vulnerability assessments



## Geographical scope of the CASE Project

- Scope of potential Partner States:
  - Countries in the Arabian Peninsula
  - Member States of African Union
  - Morocco
  - Other countries in the region upon specific request of the European Commission



## Crucial role of regional organisations

- Raising awareness and informing Members about activities
- Identifying national/regional priorities
- Potential joint organisation of regional workshops
- Nomination by ACAC and AFCAC (CAFAC) for ECAC workshops in Paris
